PD Goal:

B - Support staff will be working on the goals of their Professional Growth Plans in addition to attending various school based sessions that will enhance their skills and knowledge.

What data are you using to focus on this goal?

A - Teachers will be using data compiled from prior assessments and screenings to guide the learning and implementation of the DIBELS program.

B - Support staff will rely on their Professional Growth Plans and professional needs to guide their learning this day.

PD Activit(y)ies:

A - Teachers will be attending a full day workshop (Part one of two). Certified DIBELS trainers will work through the training modules to instruct on the screening process and the importance of developing interventions that may be needed to address needs that may arise from the screening.

B - Support staff will attend a variety of workshops and sessions including a presentation by our health unit nurse, a roundtable discussion on autism, and supports for students experiencing trauma and self-regulation difficulties.
